MEMBERSHIP

Regional Team Membership dues for the 2009-2010 season will be \$350.00 for 14-18 under and \$200.00 for 12 and under (this fee includes tournaments chosen by each coach). Players will be given Sponsor letters to assist them with their membership dues once they make a team.

Elite Regional Team Membership dues will be in addition to Regional dues depending on tournament locations.

Additional fees may apply towards Vertimax.

Membership Try-Out fee includes a **non-refundable \$50.00 fee** due at Registration. Two uniform jerseys and team duffle bag will be provided by JAVA for use by each player during the season. The season begins week after try-outs in November and continues through beginning of April each year.

TOURNAMENTS

14-18 and under players will attend minimum of 5 and/or up to a possible maximum of 7 Tournaments from January through beginning of April, depending on age group. 12 and under players will attend a maximum of 3 tournaments.

JAVA Player's Code of Conduct

1. All players will demonstrate a high level of respect for others at all times. This includes, but is not limited to: other players, teammates, coaches, officials, chaperones, and fans.
2. Upon arriving at a tournament, all players must immediately report to their coach.
3. After checking in with the coach, players are responsible for letting the coach and team Parent Representative know of their whereabouts at all times.
4. Any player caught using or possessing alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs will be immediately removed from their team. A meeting between the JAVA Club Director(s), coach, player, and her parents will be held to determine what disciplinary action will take place.
5. Volleyball specific clothing will be worn to practices, tournaments, and club functions. No spaghetti straps, low cut tops or bare midriffs allowed. The girls are athletes and should dress appropriately.
6. Players and parents will read **Players/Parents Handbook** and **Parent Code of Conduct Handbook** and sign each handbook's Memorandum of Understanding, acknowledging participation conditions while being a member of JAVA.
7. All JAVA players are required to have as much **fun** as possible while working hard to improve themselves as both players and young adults.
